5. Ask your Representative to support H.J. RES. 55, the **bipartisan resolution calling for a plan to end the war**. Call the Capitol Switchboard at 202-224-3121.

6. Share the **G.I. Rights Hotline number** with a friend in the military wanting to know info about grievance procedures, military discharges, and other civil rights. It's a network of nonprofit, nongovernmental organizations who provide information. Call the Hotline at: **(800) 394-9544**

7. Help make returning Iraq vets aware of **Them Bones Veteran Community**, an agency that is non-governmental (for complete confidentiality) that serves persons who have been deployed and their significant others. Them Bones offers counseling services, psychotherapy, war trauma recovery groups, and support groups.
