TRAVELING WALL

The Traveling Wall is a project of the Intercommunity Justice and Peace Center.

Purpose

The purpose of the project is to educate the public about the Wall of Separation/ Security Wall being erected on Palestinian territory by the Government of Israel. It is not a comment on the ethnic or religious values of the Israeli or Palestinian people. Those who borrow the Traveling Wall agree to be respectful of Islamic, Jewish and Christian beliefs in all materials and activities used in connection with the project.

Components

The Traveling Wall Project consists of:

1. A model of a piece of the wall measuring approximately 10 feet by 11 feet and 4 feet wide at the base., (The words, "Will the Wall Bring Peace" are on the front and back of the canvas covering.)
2. Six (6) poster size informational display boards,
3. A painting by artist Mary Ann Lederer,
4. An educational handout.

Information About the Construction and Transportation of the Wall

The model of the wall is made of 3 inch schedule 40 PVC and canvas. It can be used indoors or outdoors. PVC does break, especially when exposed to cold temperatures. It is light weight and will have to be securely anchored, by sand bags or another method, if used outdoors. A set of direction for assembly will be sent with the display and can be emailed to participating organizations in advance.

A van or truck that can accommodate 11' plastic pipe will be needed for transport of the project.
